

Summer of Love brings together two moments of history: turn of the century Vienna and 1967 London. The original play La Ronde was a playful but insightful look at a decadent and wild city, controversial in its time.

This new adaptation finds parallels in London during a fascinating period of change. It was the hippie era when rock music told the stories of the time. The war in Vietnam was raging, the contraceptive pill had been legalised, the Women's Liberation Movement was evolving, street fashion was exuberant and the generation gap widened.

The play takes place against this backdrop as various couples from different class backgrounds meet, connect and move on, and features the Level 3 students from BA(Hons) Acting in collaboration with the Diploma in Theatre Production and Management programme.

Transition: a change or shift from one state, subject or place to another.



The act of transition itself has become a place we inhabit, and it is from this liminal space of potential and possibilities that we consider some of the post-pandemic world's most urgent questions.

What would a more equal fashion ecosystem look like? How can the designers of tomorrow be guided by greater empathy, inclusivity and diversity? And most importantly, how do we care for each other in a changed world?

Transition marks LASALLE's return to a physical fashion show after three years. We celebrate the confidence, resilience and agility of our graduating BA(Hons) Fashion Design and Textiles cohort, who present their final collections on an open-air runway along LASALLE's picturesque sky bridge. From reflections on craft and heritage to bold new explorations, these 12 diverse collections promise to enthral and surprise.

The exhibition presents the final works of 13 graduating students from LASALLE's MA Fine Arts programme. Featuring a range of techniques and media including installation, painting, video, photography, sculpture and drawing, the exhibition offers visitors a unique opportunity to experience the results achieved by these artists.

The title of this year's exhibition considers these questions: Are reasonings needed in the process of making meaning and making art? Are all artistic practices biomythographies (à la Audre Lorde) to a certain extent, and that art-making on its own is a form of poetic encounter with different realities? Are fables proxies of life? Do we need some forms of logic to help us maintain temporary closures and make sense of things as we journey to find our voice and vocabulary to speak about our stories and our works?

The Class of 2023 entered the programme with different personal histories and professional backgrounds. From the beginning of 2022, they have worked to challenge and extend their practice through sustained research, artistic experimentation and dialogue, with the guidance of LASALLE lecturers, supervisors as well as external guests and industry professionals.


