





Behind the journey of discovery is a person engaged in a process of asking questions, delving into ideas, plunging feet first into new territory and meeting challenges.


Witness the discoveries the MA Arts and Cultural Leadership graduands made on their dissertation and research journeys, and get to know the faces and personalities behind the research.


