Film Screening: Who Are The Chetti Melaka?

Shot in Singapore and Melaka in a documentary style, the film *Who Are The Chetti Melaka?* presents the journey of Chetti Melaka youths in search of their roots. Art exhibition: Image and Sound of Fragrance

Milenko Prvacki, artist and senior fellow from LASALLE College of the Arts Singapore, collaborates with 8 artists to express the unique aroma of Little India through the visualisation of sound and image. Visitors can encounter the neighborhood in this exhibition that features images, movements, devices, paintings, and sculptures. Murals and installation art

In today's society where phubbers are all over, do not forget to look around and be the moment. After all, some experiences cannot be conveyed through photos or videos. For example, on the wall of the Park 22 hotel in Little India, a mural called *In the Clouds* by visual artist Speak Cryptic's is an interweaving of floral motifs with patterns found on Indian sarees. One look at the mural and it immediately calls to mind the scent of garlands found throughout the precinct.
