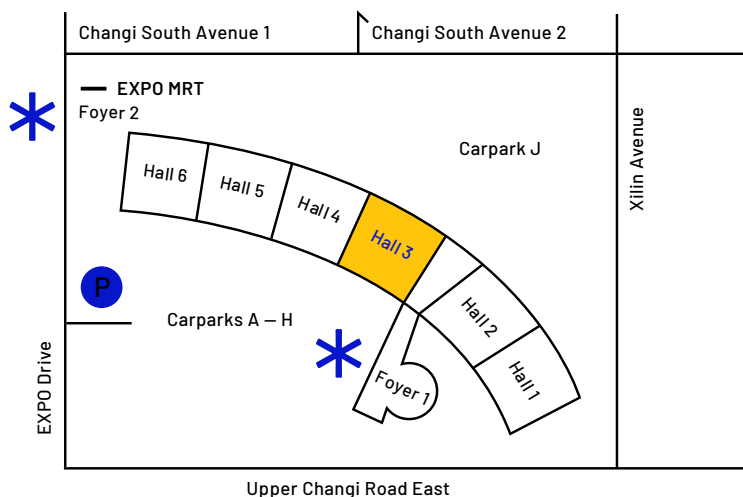
Safe management measures

We are committed to creating a safe and meaningful Convocation experience for you. For the health and safety of all graduands and guests, and in line with recommendations and guidelines from the Ministry of Health (MOH) and Ministry of Education (MOE), the following safe management measures will be implemented at the Convocation ceremonies:

- Mandatory SafeEntry check-in to the venue at designated entry points via the TraceTogether (TT) app or token. Please refer to the location map below:

- Singapore Expo has installed the SafeEntry Gateway which allows check-ins by scanning a TT app or token.
- Sanitation of high touch point surfaces including door handles and escalator handrails as well as cleaning of common areas is conducted regularly with SGClean guidelines.
- A holding room is available outside the venue for any suspected COVID-19 cases.
- For health and safety reasons, guest below the age of 5 and above the age of 70 are discouraged from attending the in-person Convocation.
- Kindly refrain from attending the in-person Convocation if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 including but not limited to fever, runny nose, sore throat, loss of taste and smell, etc. You may still attend Convocation online.

General information

Attendance at the LASALLE Convocation ceremonies is strictly by invitation and registration only.

To be allowed entry into the Convocation venue, you must have either:

1. Completed the full COVID-19 vaccination regimen (two doses of any vaccination approved under the WHO Emergency Use Listing (WHO-EUL) at least two weeks before the Convocation ceremony, or
2. Possess a valid negative COVID-19 Pre-Event Test (PET) result. LASALLE has appointed Minmed Group Pte Ltd to provide the ART for graduands attending the in-person Convocation. Unvaccinated guests can take their one-time Antigen Rapid Test (ART) at Minmed's clinics or any of the Ministry of Health's approved test providers. Guests will bear the full cost of ART. Please note that the ART has a validity of 24 hours. Guests will have to time their ART so that the validity covers up to the end of the ceremony.
3. Recovered from a COVID-19 infection with a valid PET exemption letter.

Registration for guests

Registration closes on 15 September 2021 for the Class of 2020 and 22 September for the Class of 2021.

The following measures must be strictly observed at all times during registration:

- Face masks must be worn throughout.
- Please arrive at the venue at least one hour prior to the start of the ceremony to accommodate TraceTogether check-in and registration. The ceremony will begin on schedule and latecomers will not be allowed entry.
- While queuing to register, please remember the following:
- Keep a distance of 1 metre apart.
- Get ready your NRIC/FIN to be scanned when you arrive at the counter.

- Get ready your vaccination status, valid negative ART result or valid PET exemption letter.

In compliance with the Personal Data Protection Act, you will be deemed to have provided consent to the collection of your personal data for the purpose of attending this event. Your personal data will only be used to verify your vaccination status against your personal identification number, and this data will be expunged immediately after the event.

During the ceremony

- Once inside the hall, you are encouraged to fill the front rows in the appropriate zones. Guest seats are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Please refrain from sitting in the VIP reserved seating area or the graduates' seating area.
- Guests are to be seated once they enter the hall and remain seated throughout the ceremony. Please do not exit the hall as no re-entry is allowed.
- You may take photographs and/or videos from your seat but no standing, cheering or leaving of seats to take photographs or videos is allowed throughout the ceremony. Please also refrain from flash photography or video recording during the ceremony.
- All mobile and beeping devices are to be switched to silent mode when the ceremony is in progress. No loud cheering is allowed.
- Graduands and guests must vacate the premises immediately at the end of the ceremony as the venue will be cleaned and sanitised for the next session. To ensure the smooth ingress of the next sessions' attendees, please do not loiter or hang around outside the venue and around the registration areas.
