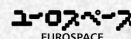

Message from the Festival

This programme presents an attitude toward creation, rather than a collection of remarkable animations.

For that reason, we do not provide plot synopses or artist statements for the films. What matters here is not understanding what the works are about, but simply sitting down and experiencing the joy of creation that runs through them. These films are united not by quality, style, technique or subject matter, but by the sincerity of people making something because they wanted to make it.

As much as possible, The Most Trash Animation Festival avoids making judgments. Instead of relying on a centralised jury, we adopt an open exhibition and evaluation model: anyone who wishes to screen films from the festival is free to do so. Each studio/cinema/bookstore/café etc. may create its own awards, complete with unique names and visual identities, and invite audiences to vote for the films they believe deserve them.

However, once we call ourselves a festival and present a screening program, it becomes impossible to avoid selection altogether—even if we would rather not make those decisions.

Therefore, the selection and programming method for this screening in Singapore is as follows:

All films that have previously received awards are arranged according to the total number of awards they have accumulated across different venues, from fewest to most. As a result, the final film in the program is also the one that has received the greatest number of awards, making it, by public consensus, the Most Trash Animation of the screening.

We hope you will stay until the very end.
